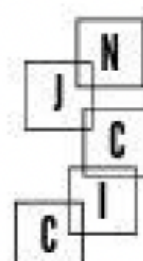
Our invited guests, Michael E. Campion, Chief of the Civil Rights Unit, and Assistant U.S. Attorney Kelly Florio, will discuss:
