

TRUMP'S EDUCATION BUDGET: THE IMPACT *on* NEW JERSEY

UNDER TRUMP'S BUDGET, NATIONWIDE:

\$9 billion
would be cut from the U.S.
Department of Education.

Federal investments in school
privatization would exceed
\$20 billion.¹

IN NEW JERSEY:

New Jersey schools stand to
lose more than
\$100 million.



COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

The elimination of the
**21st Century Community
Center Learning grants,**
totaling more than
\$22 million,
would jeopardize
before, after, and summer
school programs that
support at-risk students
with safe spaces for
academic enrichment.



PRESCHOOL

The elimination of the
**Preschool Development
Grant, totaling**
\$17.5 million,
would prematurely end
federal support for the
expansion of full-day,
high-quality preschool to
17 low-income
communities. More than
2,000 children would have
benefited from new
preschool slots or
improved programs.²



STUDENT SUPPORT

Trump plans to cut over
\$11 million
by eliminating the **Title
IV Student Support and
Academic Enrichment
Grant.** This grant supports
strategies for improving
conditions for student
learning, such as
promoting a positive
school climate and social
emotional learning,
reducing chronic
absenteeism, and
reducing exclusionary
disciplinary practices.³



TEACHER TRAINING

Trump plans to cut over
\$50 million
of **Title II funding**
which promotes student
success by preparing,
training, and recruiting
high-quality teachers.
These cuts would reduce
professional development
opportunities that
teachers and principals
need to be effective
educators.

TAKE ACTION NOW

These cuts would diminish equal opportunity and increase racial and economic inequities. If this proposed budget passes, more education cuts can be expected in New Jersey. Economically disadvantaged students, English language learners, and students with disabilities would be affected the most.

Call your Congressional Delegation to stand up for their students by rejecting this devastating budget proposal.
