- I, Katherine Attwood, of full age, hereby certify that:
- 1. I am the Assistant Commissioner of the Division of Finance, Department of Education ("Department"). I offer this certification by way of supplement to my March 17, 2008 certification and June 9, 2008 certification in this matter.
- 2. All of the amicus Districts, with the exception of Camden, submitted, and the Department approved, district budgets by March 1, 2008.
- 3. A comparison of the Abbott districts' 2008-2009 spending with the Adequacy Budget plus categorical aids (security

and one-third special education) shows that 20 districts are spending above adequacy in 2008-2009. <u>See</u> Exhibit A, <u>Abbott Spending Versus Adequacy Budget with Categoricals</u>, <u>Fiscal Year 2008-2009</u>.

- All of the amicus districts generate educational 4. resources (FTEs) under the enhanced PJP model that significantly exceed the resources of the  $\underline{Abbott\ V}$  model. To demonstrate this point, utilizing the Abbott V comparative charts in Certification of Lucille Davy, Exhibit H, charts have been created for each amicus District that prorate the enhanced PJP model to actual enrollment and the  $\underline{Abbott\ V}$  model to actual enrollment for Kindergarten to Grade 5 students (elementary school), grade 6 to 8students (middle school) and grade 9 to 12 students (high school) for that district. The enhanced PJP model with actual enrollment is then compared to the  $\underline{Abbott\ V}$  model with actual enrollment and the difference noted.
- 5. Additionally, a summary chart has been created for each amicus district that summarizes total district enrollment, total district at-risk enrollment, total district LEP enrollment, district at-risk percentage, and PJP at-risk weight. Also included on the summary charts are the additional personnel (FTE) resources over the Abbott V model at the elementary, middle and high school level. Finally, the summary includes the additional at-risk and LEP resources and the 2008 Title I funds generated for the district
