I, YUT'SE THOMAS, being of full age, hereby certify that:

1. I am the Director of the Office of School Funding, Department of Education ("Department"), and have been employed by the Department for the previous eighteen years.

2. As Director, and with the assistance of my staff, I am responsible for administering the State aid system for school districts in accordance with applicable statutes; calculating, disbursing and accounting for all statutorily state funded aid programs; administering, collecting and validating the audit summary and school register data; preparing school finance statistics; conducting the necessary research and preparing the

reports required by the school funding law; and performing State aid simulations relative to future school finance trends and proposed legislation.

3. In preparing this Certification I have relied upon my knowledge and experience as Director, my staff, the underlying data used for the State aid Notices sent to each school district by the Department, the budget data submitted by each school district, and the school based budget data submitted by each school district formerly known as Abbott districts.

4. Attached as Exhibit A is a chart that demonstrates the State aid reductions by at-risk concentration. Exhibit A was created as an expanded version of Exhibit C to the Certification of Melvin L. Wyns (Wyns' Chart), submitted in support of Plaintiff's motion. Both charts represent the FY 2011 state aid reductions according to at-risk concentrations of students. Both charts utilize the same number of districts and the same estimated resident enrollment for FY 2011. Both charts also use state aid figures for FY 2010 and FY 2011. While the total aid amounts are the same, the state aid amounts broken down according to percentage of at-risk students are slightly different between Wyns' Chart and Exhibit A. Exhibit A reflects the most current and accurate data retained by the Department. Exhibit A was then expanded to include FY 2010 resident enrollment which does not appear on Wyns' Chart. Exhibit A was also expanded to show the per pupil aid amounts for FY 2010 and FY 2011 and to include the percentage of aid

difference on a per pupil basis between FY 2010 and FY 2011 neither of which were included in the Wync's chart.

5. Attached as Exhibit B is a chart that demonstrates the State aid reductions for FY 2011 from FY 2010 by district factor group.

6. Attached as Exhibit C is a chart that demonstrates the Abbott Districts' proportion of State aid for FY 2010 and FY 2011 compared to all other districts.

7. Attached as Exhibit D is a chart that compares State aid for FY 2010 to State aid for FY 2011 based on the category of State aid.

8. Attached as Exhibit E is a chart summarizing State aid differences between FY 2010 and FY 2011 to all districts, sorted by percentage aid difference.

9. Attached as Exhibit F is a chart that sets forth the FY 2011 State aid to Abbott Districts according to aid category.

10. Attached as Exhibit G is a chart that sets forth the FY 2011 State aid reductions to Abbott Districts in each aid category.


11. Attached as Exhibit H is a chart providing the revenues per pupil for FY 2011 in all K-12 districts.

13. Attached as Exhibit J is a line graph plotting the

averages of the revenues per pupil for the Abbott districts, non-Abbott districts and I and J districts from FY 1998 through FY 2011. Revenue per pupil is the sum of the local levy and total aid (except transportation, preschool, and debt service), less transfers to preschool; divided by resident enrollment reduced by one half of the half-day Kindergarten student count. The FY 2010 revenues are based on the budgeted data. Districts that have not submitted FY 2011 budgets may still include preschool transfers. Districts include all local and regional school districts (non-operating, elementary, high school only, and K-12 districts). County Vocational Districts, Special Services Districts, and ESCs and Jointures are not included.

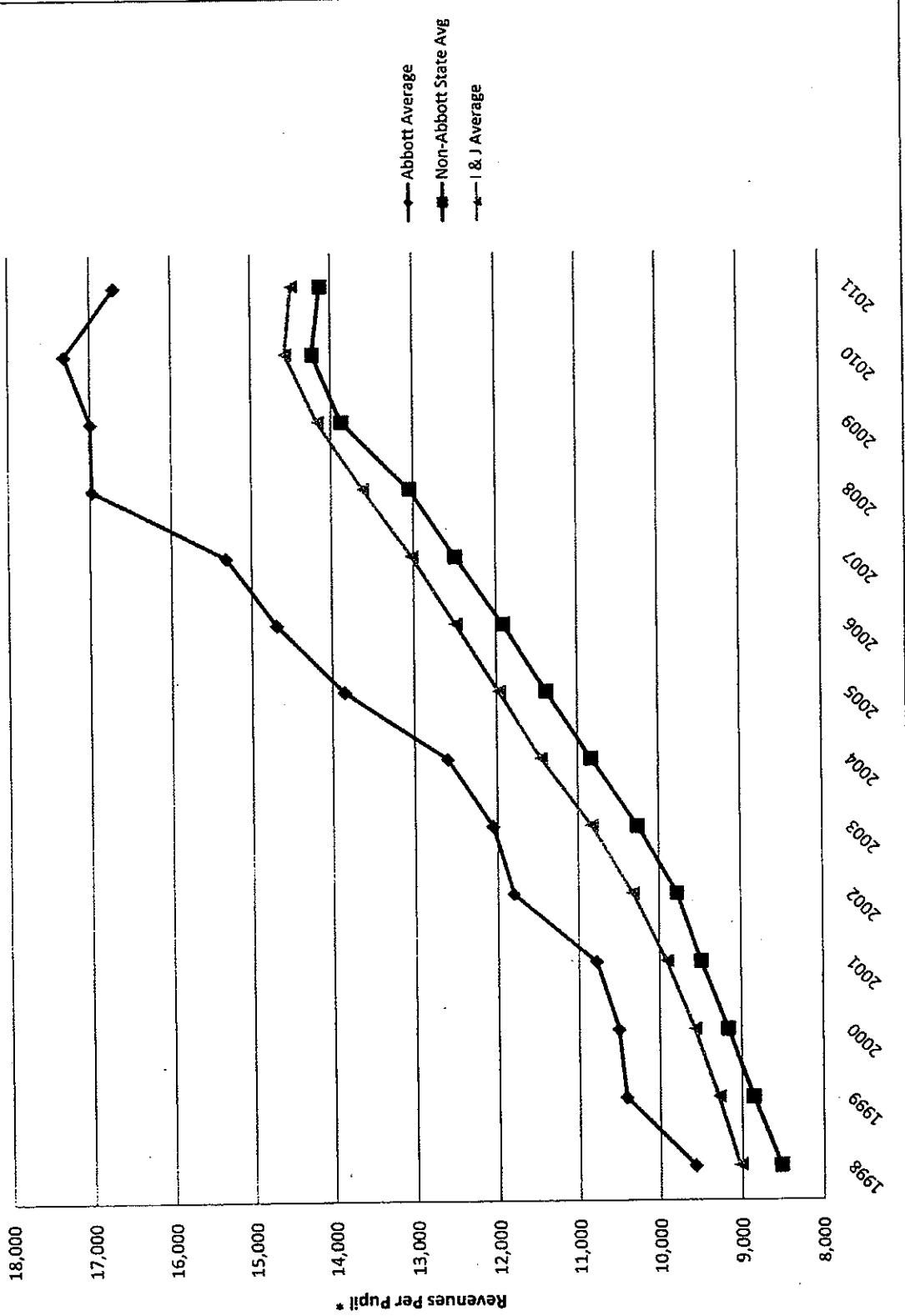
