I, Kevin Dehmer, of full age, hereby certify that:

1. I am the Chief Financial Officer of the New Jersey Department of Education ("Department"). In this capacity I am responsible for overseeing the activities of the Office of School Facilities and Finance, the Office of State Monitors, the Office of Budget, and the Office of Accounting.

2. I have held several positions at the Department since my employment began in 2007. Most recently, I held the position of Executive Director of the Office of School Facilities and

Finance. In that capacity, I was involved in the preparation of State aid notices to all school districts and the distribution of aid as determined each year in the annual Appropriations Act.

3. I have a Bachelor's degree in Economics and Political Science from St. John's University (MN) as well as a Master's of Public Policy with a concentration in Education Policy from Rutgers University.

4. School districts are funded through their local tax levies as well as their receipt of both federal and state aid. There are other revenue sources, such as student fees, however these comprise a relatively small portion of most district's revenue.

5. The projected FY2017 combined funding for the 31 SDA Districts is \$6,200,671,333. Of this, \$5,095,234,707 will come from the State of New Jersey; \$305,375,446 is estimated to come from federal aid; and \$800,061,180 will come from local tax levies. Thus the majority of SDA Districts' funding comes from the State of New Jersey. Exhibit A sets forth the projected state, federal, and local revenues for FY2017.

a. Calculating the exact amount of federal aid is a complicated process due to the way different types of federal aid are distributed. Federal funding for FY2017 is best estimated by using the amount of federal aid included in each district's latest

audit. The most recent audit is from FY2015. Thus, the best estimate of federal funding for FY2017 is \$305,375,446 for all SDA Districts, the combined federal aid amount from each district's FY2015 audit. Federal aid awards to SDA Districts are set forth in Exhibits A and B, attached hereto.

6. The manner of State funding for schools since the Supreme Court's first Abbott v. Burke decision in 1985 resulted in an increased share of total State education aid dollars shifting to the SDA Districts, particularly over the last roughly 20 years.

7. Since FY1985, the State has allocated billions of dollars to the SDA Districts for K-12 and preschool. Exhibit C indicates the Total State Aid awarded to the SDA Districts from FY1985 to FY2017, as compared to the Total State Aid awarded to non-SDA Districts and All Districts, including SDA Districts. State aid to the SDA Districts at the start of this period was about \$685 million and, by FY2017, had climbed to \$5.095 billion. For non-SDA Districts, the State aid allocation in FY1985 was \$1.049 billion, which rose to \$3.587 billion in FY2017. As illustrated in Exhibit C:

- a. In FY1985, State aid to SDA Districts represented 39.5% of the total preschool-12 State aid distributed in that year.

- b. In FY1998, that percentage increased to approximately 48.5%. At that time, the number of students in the SDA Districts was about 22% of all students in the State
- c. In FY2017, SDA Districts will be receiving nearly 59% of all preschool-12 State aid distributed, while their proportionate student enrollment has remained relatively constant. Projected SDA District enrollment for FY2017 is 22.8% of the State's total student population.

8. Thus, in the years that have passed since the Court's decision in Abbott v. Burke, 110 N.J. 269 (1985) ("Abbott I"), the amount of aid provided to the SDA Districts, as well as the SDA Districts' proportion of total State aid, increased.

9. Budgetary per pupil cost (Indicator 1), sometimes referred to as average per pupil spending, is a measure compiled by the Department each year as part of the Taxpayers' Guide to Education Spending (TGES, formerly known as the Comparative Spending Guide). This measure allows for a comparison of the costs included in a district's general and special revenue fund budgets on a per pupil basis. Some items, such as facilities acquisition and construction, are excluded from this measure because they are not common and uniform across districts and to ensure that the per pupil expenditure measure can be reasonably

compared across districts. Exhibit D sets forth the budgetary per pupil cost, or average per pupil spending, for SDA Districts, non-SDA Districts, and the Statewide average. Exhibit E sets forth the average per pupil spending for each SDA District for the 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 school years.

10. In addition to receiving State aid, each district is required to raise a portion of its budget through local property taxes. A calculation of each district's estimated ability to raise local levy to support local schools is required as part of the SFRA and is referred to as the district's "local fair share." A district's local fair share is based on the district's property valuation and income relative to all other districts, and is calculated pursuant to the formula set forth at N.J.S.A. 18A:7F-52. Attached as Exhibit F are charts showing, for fiscal years 2010-2017, the SDA district local levies as compared to each district's local fair share. Note that the "local levy" column in the charts reflects the prebudget (prior) year school levy, which is compared to the current year local fair share in the "local fair share" column. In addition, for fiscal years 2010-2017, the summary of levy growth chart shows the percent increase in school levy from the previous year. From FY2009 through FY2011, school districts were not permitted to increase their school levy by more than 4% over the previous year, with certain exceptions. Starting in


FY2012, P.L. 2010, c.44 went into effect, reducing the levy cap to 2% and eliminating many of the exceptions. In FY2012, there were 12 SDA districts that increased their levy from the prior year, a decline from the 18 that did so in FY2011. In FY2013 11 out of the 31 SDA districts increased their levy from the prior year.

11. Exhibit F shows that, from FY2010 through FY2017, only one or two of 31 SDA Districts (depending on the year) raised a local school tax levy of at least the amount of the district's local fair share. In FY2017, 29 of the 31 SDA Districts raised a local school tax levy that was less than the district's local fair share, 19 of which raised a local school tax levy that was less than 60% of the local fair share.

12. More specifically, in FY2010, Hoboken raised a local school tax levy that was 35.2% of its local fair share and in FY2017, Hoboken's local school tax levy was 23.5% of its local fair share. In FY2010, Jersey City raised a local school tax that was 40.3% of its local fair share and, in FY2017, the levy was 35.6% of local fair share. Asbury Park raised a local school tax levy that was 55.4% of its local fair share in FY2010, which compares to 42.6% in FY2017. A final example is Camden City which raised a local school tax levy that was 39.2% of its local fair share in FY2010, compared to 29.6% in FY2017.

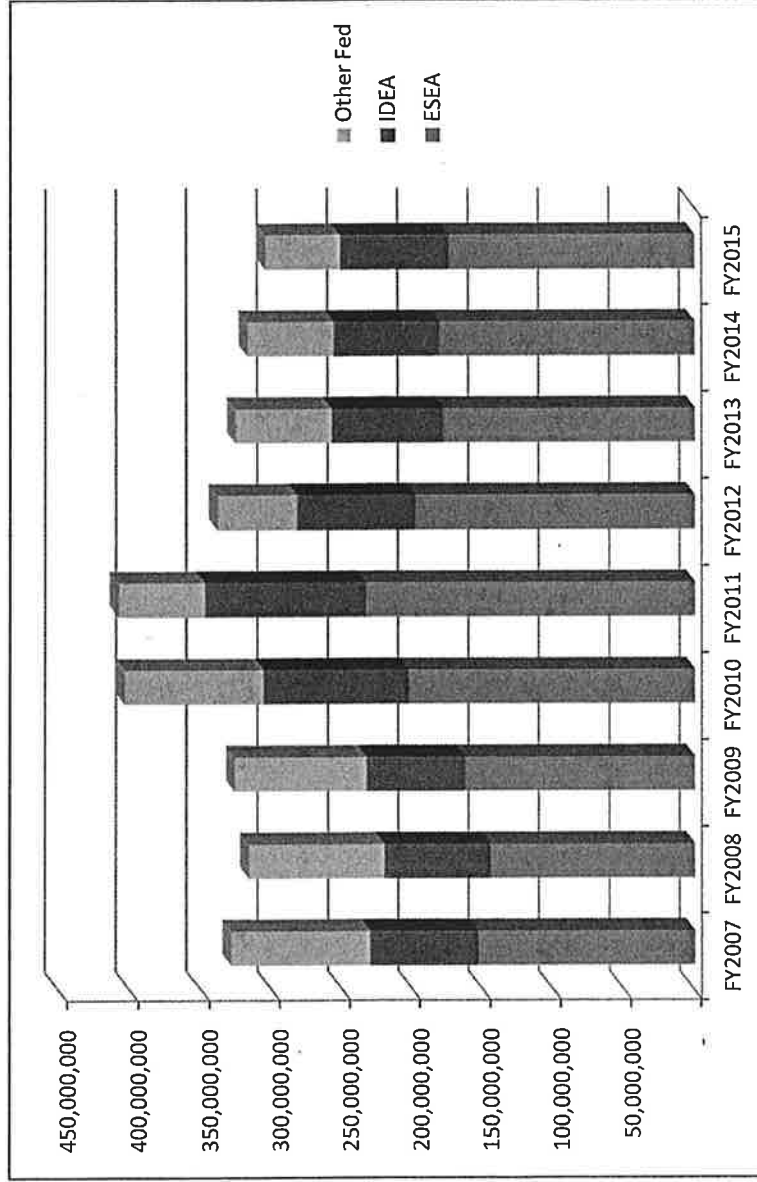
