PROTECTING YOUR CHILD'S RIGHT TO COMPENSATORY EDUCATION

This Webinar is for parents and caregivers of children with disabilities whose IEPs were not being implemented after all schools in NJ shut down in March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. For many, if not all, of the children with disabilities impacted by COVID, parents/caregivers must resolve their COVID-related compensatory education claims with school districts or file for a due process hearing **by March 18, 2022**— if you do not resolve the issue or file by **March 18, 2022**, your children will lose at least some of their special education claim and remedy.

This webinar will provide a brief overview of compensatory education: what is it, when students may be entitled to compensatory education, and how it can be provided. Experienced panelists will also discuss the following:

- IEP meeting to discuss student's need for compensatory education.
- Date by which claims for compensatory education during pandemic must be filed.
- Proposed legislation to extend time to file claims.
- How to file for due process and what to include in petition when you:
 - Believe student is entitled to compensatory education and/or
 - Disagree with IEP team's decision to graduate student.
